The event will be held at Woodbine Beach (Woodbine Beach Loop, Toronto, ON, M4L 3W6).

Below is the format for each division, followed by the game schedule.

#### **Adult Division**

- Format:
  - o The four teams in each pool will play each other once, followed by placement games for 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th.
- Gender Ratio:
  - o We will be following Gender Rule A. At the start of the game, an additional disc flip happens with the winner selecting the gender ratio for the first point. For the second and third points the ratio must be the reverse of the first point. For the fourth and fifth points the ratio must be the same as the first point. This pattern of alternating the ratio every two points repeats until the end of the game (half time has no impact on the pattern). So if for example, the captain who wins the flip selected the gender ratio of the first point to be 3:2 then the ratio pattern would be. First point 3:2, then 2:3, 2:3, 3:2, 3:2, 2:3 and so on. This pattern is not interrupted by halftime.

- Format:
  - o The four teams in each pool will play each other once, followed by placement games for 1st, and 3rd.
- Gender Ratio:
  - We will be following Gender Rule A. At the start of the game, an additional disc flip happens with the winner selecting the gender ratio for the first point. For the second and third points the ratio must be the reverse of the first point. For the fourth and fifth points the ratio must be the same as the first point. This pattern of alternating the ratio every two points repeats until the end of the game (half time has no impact on the pattern).   - The four teams in each pool will play each other once, followed by placement games for 1<sup>st</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Gender Ratio:
  - We will be following Gender Rule A. At the start of the game, an additional disc flip happens with the winner selecting the gender ratio for the first point. For the second and third points the ratio must be the reverse of the first point. For the fourth and fifth points the ratio must be the same as the first point. This pattern of alternating the ratio every two points repeats until the end of the game (half time has no impact on the pattern). So if for example, the captain who wins the flip selected the gender ratio of the first point to be 3:2 then the ratio pattern would be. First point 3:2, then 2:3, 2:3, 3:2, 3:2, 2:3 and so on. #### Field Map

Woodbine Beach Woodbine Beach Loop, Toronto, ON, M4L 3W6

**TC** – Tournament Control. Please report all scores here!

**Field 1** – the most northerly west field.

**Field 2** – the west field just south of Field 1.

Field 3 – the most southerly west field.

**Field 4** – the most northerly east field closest to the east parking lot.

**Toilets/Washrooms** – public washrooms are located in the pavilion that is on the northeast side of the field, adjacent to pool.

**Parking** – There are several paid parking lots at Woodbine Beach, all located to the west of Tournament Central. There is also limited street parking, north of the beach and Lakeshore Blvd.

**Water** – Water will be available onsite via water cooler water bottles. Please bring a full water bottle in the morning.

**Food** – Please bring your own snacks and/or lunch for fueling between games.

**Garbage** – At Tournament Central we will have receptacles for you to place your recyclables and non-recyclable waste. We do ask that all garbage be placed in the receptables provided by TUC and or the city. We want to leave the Beach cleaner than we found it!





## Equipment / Team Jerseys (Colour)

Teams, please communicate with your teammates regarding shirt/jersey colours including the extra "opposite" shirt/jersey (dark or light). TUC HAT team players, please bring a white and a black shirt/jersey.

#### **Tournament Rules**

**Game Timing** – Whistle/horn will be used to keep time throughout the day. Two blasts will signal the end of the time slot. One blast will denote the official start of the game slot.

**Game Length** – All games will be 40 minutes in length!

Stall Count - Stall count is 10!

**Half-Time** – Half-time should occur after one team reaches 6 points, or at the conclusion of the first point to begin after the 20-minute mark (whichever comes first). Half-time is simply used to reverse the pull situation from the start of the game – there should be NO extended half-time "break".

Ties – When the whistle/horn blows, finish the current point. If the game is tied, play a universe point.

Timeouts – There will be one 60-second timeout per team per game. No timeouts are allowed in the last 5 minutes of the game.

Brick Mark - The Brick Mark is 15m from the endzone line.

Gender Ratio - Gender Rule A.

**Foot blocks** – Per TUC rules, foot blocks are not allowed.

Rules – Other than the rules listed above, all games will follow BULA/WFDF Beach Rules.

## Seeding and Tiebreaker

When determining seeding, the teams will be selected on the following criteria:

- Win-loss record. If still tied, then,
- Head-to-head record. If still tied, then,
- Goal differential (i.e. plus-minus). Please note the maximum plus-minus for any game will be +7/-7. If still tied, then,
- One throw closest to the target!



# Scorekeeping and Score Reporting

TUC will provide a scoreboard at each field.

All teams are asked to nominate a scorekeeper to keep track of the score throughout the game.

TUC will have volunteers on-site to collect game scores and report them to Tournament Control.

## First Aid/Physio

Physio will not be available on-site during this tournament. TUC staff will have a First Aid Kit available for minor injuries.

#### **Toilets and Changing Rooms**

Both male and female toilets/washrooms will be available at the venue, at the pavilion that is to the East of the fields at the public pool, a short walk from the fields.

Tournament Control will be located between Field 1 and Field 4.
