### Good Sportsmanship and Code of Conduct and Ethics

The Toronto Ultimate Club would like to remind all participants of our TUC policies, specifically our Code of Conduct (<u>Adults</u>) and <u>Concussion</u> Policies. We would also like to remind everyone that the "Summer Experience - Connectfest" event is a tournament for FUN, so please enjoy the event and play with SPIRIT. We wish you all the best in enjoying what will hopefully be one of the highlights of the ultimate playing season.

The event will be held at Sunnybrook Park on the Field Hockey Fields (1116 Leslie Street, Toronto, ON).

Below is the format for each division, followed by the game schedule.

#### **Adult Division**

- Total Entries: 4
- Teams:
  - Team 1 Three Cheers For (Tyson Parent Captain),
  - o Team 2 MicroDiscs (Brenda Perras Captain),
  - Team 3 HAT Team 1,
  - Team 4 HAT Team 2.
- Format (UPDATE):
  - o Due to some Junior withdrawals, as of 25 July @ 12noon, we will go with a 5v5 format.
  - o Note: we may shift to 6v6 if the pending registrations from this morning come through by the End of Day Today.



#### • Gender Ratio (UPDATE):

- Modified Rule A, with captains able to agree to changes if they want (and encouraged to do so if it provides more equal playing time for *both* teams).
  - For 5v5, the first point of every game will be 3:2, then 4:1, 4:1, 3:2, 3:2, 4:1, 4:1 and so on. This pattern is not interrupted by halftime.
  - For 6v6, the first point of every game will be 3:3, then 4:2, 4:2, 3:3, 3:3, 4:2, 4:2 and so on. This pattern is not interrupted by halftime.
- o Additionally, on all 3:2 (of 3:3 points for 6v6), a female-matching player must pull to start the point.

#### Tournament Game Schedule and Format:

o Format will be a round-robin of 3 games per team, followed by finals and placement games.

## Field Map

Sunnybrook Park – Field Hockey Fields 1116 Leslie Street, Toronto, ON

**TC** – Tournament Control. Please report all scores here!

Field 1 – the most northerly west field.

Field 2 – the west field just south of Field 1.

**Field 3** – the most southerly west field.

**Field 4** – the most northerly east field closest to the east parking lot.

Field 5 – the east field just south of Field 4.

**Field 6** – the most southerly east field closest to the east parking lot.

**Toilets/Washrooms** – public washrooms are located in the pavilion that is on the north side of the field, adjacent to Cricket North Field.

**Parking** – There are two main parking lots, one at the end of the road (hidden in the woods). The other is at the top of the hill near the cricket fields.

**Water** – Water will be available onsite via water cooler water bottles. Please bring a full water bottle in the morning.

**Food** – Please bring your own snacks and/or lunch for fueling between games.





# Equipment / Team Jerseys (Colour)

Teams, please communicate with your teammates regarding shirt/jersey colours including the extra "opposite" shirt/jersey (dark or light).

TUC HAT team players, please bring a white and a black shirt/jersey.

#### **Tournament Rules**

**Game Timing** – Whistle/horn will be used to keep time throughout the day. Two blasts will signal the end of the time slot. One blast will denote the official start of the game slot.

Game Length – All games will be 70 minutes in length!

Ties – When the whistle/horn blows, finish the current point. If the game is tied, play a universe point.

Timeouts – There will be two 60-second timeouts per team per game. No timeouts are allowed in the last 5 minutes of the game.

Game Format – Due to withdrawals on 24 July, game format will be 5-v-5. We may shift to 6-v-6 before Saturday if we get additional registrations.

**Gender Ratio** – Modified Rule A, with captains being able to agree to changes if they want (and encouraged to do so if it provides more equal playing time for *both* teams). The first point of every game will be 3:2, then 4:1, 4:1, 3:2, 3:2, 4:1, 4:1 and so on. This pattern is not interrupted by halftime.

Additionally, on all 3:2 points, it must be a female-matching player pulling to start the point.

Foot blocks – Per TUC rules, foot blocks are not allowed.

Rules – Other than the rules listed above, all games will follow <u>TUC's outdoor rules</u> and the <u>USAU 2024-2025 edition rules</u>.



## Seeding and Tiebreaker

When determining seeding, the teams will be selected on the following criteria:

- Win-loss record. If still tied, then,
- Head-to-head record. If still tied, then,
- Goal differential (i.e. plus-minus). Please note the maximum plus-minus for any game will be +7/-7. If still tied, then,
- One throw closest to the target!

# Scorekeeping and Score Reporting

TUC will provide a scoreboard at each field.

All teams are asked to nominate a scorekeeper to keep track of the score throughout the game.

Both teams after the game should/need to report the score to Tournament Control.

# First Aid/Physio

Physio will not be available on-site during this tournament. TUC staff will have a First Aid Kit available for minor injuries.

# **Toilets and Changing Rooms**

Both male and female toilets/washrooms will be available at the venue, at the pavilion that is on the north side of the field (next to the Cricket North field).

Tournament Control will be located between Field 1 and Field 4.
